Call for Entries

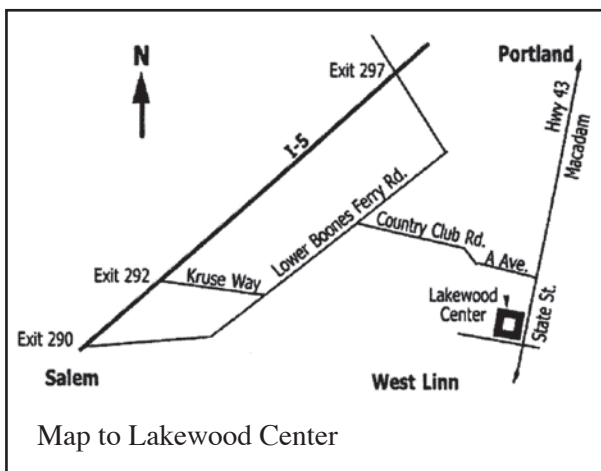
The Lake Oswego Crafts & Art League (LOCAL 14) announces its annual Scholarship Awards for college women majoring in art. LOCAL 14 is a group of women artists founded in 1968 by 14 women, to help each other promote their pursuit in the arts. It has expanded to a membership of over 50 talented women artists who, along with over 40 guest artists, produce an annual art show and sale showcasing a wide range of art and craft media. This group is dedicated to help encourage women in the arts and has thus created the LOCAL 14 Educational Foundation, founded in 1997, to provide scholarship assistance to deserving women artists.

\$6700 in awards

To be considered, applicants must fulfill these qualifications:

- ♦ Be a female art student who will be enrolled in an accredited college art program in the fall of 2010.
- ♦ Artwork must be original & in one of the following media: painting, drawing, printmaking, ceramics, photography, sculpture, metalwork, jewelry, leather, basketry, woodworking, blown & fused glass, wearable art, book arts, textiles & other well-executed arts & crafts.
- ♦ Bring three pieces of work prepared for display. 2D work must be ready to hang, with hanging fixtures attached. Delivery need not be made by the applicant, but must be adequately labeled.
- ♦ Artwork need not be all the same medium.
- ♦ Artwork that receives awards must be available for display during the LOCAL 14 Art Show & Sale, October 14 through October 17, 2010 at Miller Hall, World Forestry Center, Portland, OR. The artwork must be the EXACT work (or works) awarded at the jurying.
- ♦ Scholarship winners need to be available, if possible, for the Kick Off dinner in early September at the Lakewood Center, for the award presentation. Time and date to be announced.
- ♦ LOCAL 14 reserves the right to photograph winning artwork for publicity purposes.
